Vietnamese

It's nearly always chock-a-block at this casual Crown Street hole-in-the-wall. Dine under cover or grab a street-side table and feast on some great, reasonably-priced, home-style Vietnamese food, served with a smile. Moist nem nuong – deep-fried minced chicken skewers – dunked in sweet-sour nuoc cham dipping sauce are definitely worth a blast. So too are petite duck fillet rolls with hoisin sauce. For something more substantial, go for silken tofu, a spicy delight with its coating of Sichuan pepper, salt and chilli, or enjoy a super yellow chicken curry with hot mint and sweet dried shrimp. Xage – pronounced 'sage' – is a cheap and cheerful winner.
